WMAP's DX well received at 4:02-4:30. 11/27 - Couldn't hear WNNT's DX but got WRXO's fine. Heard WWSW's final sign off from 1490 at 6:00 a.m. 11/28 - WGBI WQAN and KCLO's DXes fairly loud.

Overslept on WMAP & WNNT, but WRXO was heard perfectly. WWSW announced switch to 970 effective this afternoon. Heard final words of the old 1500 club, which now becomes the 970 clob.
