On Saturday Ait logged both WARE and WLNA on swell DX Tests for two new ones to the Log. Then Sunday AM hrd KEPO-WAPF on nice DX Tests tho WAPF was 12 minutes late. Also hrd Welollagoke on Sunday sign on at 5:30 CST. WBRH-1250kc $s$ ign on at 5:55 AM CST. Monday-KBKW with extra swell DX Program.WPBC also hrd and reported.

The latest verifications here are cards from WGAP CFRC WIBG \& TTCO, and one lone letter from CJBR. Latest reports went out to KSL WLOG KWYO KCSU KWCR KIBE KBRS EITO WARE WINA \& WGRA. When $I$ coulin't identify the station the otners identified as a Guatemalan on 1025, I sent a letter of inquiry to HOU in David, Panama. Tolay I got a fine letter from the Secretary: HOU is officially assigned to $1025 \mathrm{kc} / \mathrm{s}$. and broadeasts daily from 8:00 a.m. to $10: 00$ p.m. Paname time. They had no special program on Christmas morning. Another latter in today's mail came from Mr. Villatte, Regional Director for Hennes and Raido France. He sayg that since $11 / 24 / 49$, Rennes has been on $968 \mathrm{~kg} / \mathrm{s}$ with a power of 100 kw . and that the stations now on 1040 are Pau -20 kw , Miontebeliard 10 ks . and Nimes 2 kw . This puts a different light on the subject of French reception on 1040. As Mr. Villatte points out in his letter, "since these transmitters broaicast the same programs, it is quite difficult to determine which of the three transmitters was heard." Only 4 numbers were copied from KOWL through WATM and they were uentioned in a thank-you letter. KOWL oame back with a swell letter verification. KSVP fail. ed to verify last year out they sent out a printed card this year. W.C.Groves, Jr. down at weNC ant a record of some kind with a 3-page verie letter. (To those who fee: that report forms are impersonal, I have been using them all the time and get sore fint, personal letters in return. In my opinion a report can be made personal and interesting whether it is on a report form or on bonded stationery. There's a heck of a lot on extra space on a report form and a report on it will be interesting if the DXer does more than fill in blaniss.) Amezes me that you DXers are able to decipher much of anything out of the nomal nash on a local channel at any hour of day or night. Imagine you would have bettar results with a semi-horizontal polarizam: tion on your antenna, 73, de Bud Crapford, KCNI.". That to meis a fine verie. Naturaily, many veries, if they come back at all, are dahed off by someone who has a millior other things to do. And like Howard Bair, the CE of MCMB, located several doors from: my office, has told me - it is surprising the number of letters he receives with about this mich information - "Heard you play 'Dardanella on the first. Please send me a verification." I have sent out more than 1 report on f/os or programs on which I heard only 1 or 2 positive identifictions. WMHT.is an example. Last Oct. I caught 2 weak, partial identifications on a f/c that did not agree with their schedule as we have it listed. In a fow days I received a z-page petter, written in longhand from their CE, telling me how much he appreciated the rpt \& why the check was run on a date other than their reguilar orie. It seems that they couldn't reach the lab in KC when they tried on their regular f/c! Andther example is the vy nice letter I recd this AM from Thonas T. Ely, CE of KIXX. I've been trying for 3 yrs . to log them. Finally caught about 10 min . of what I thought was a program of theirs early in the AM of the loth. That night I again hrd the same stations beforemidnight. PST \& caught I identification. Listed what I heard both times in a report \& Mr. Ely verified each \& said he was surprised I was able to hear them at all due to the fact that they have: a sharp "null" (whatever that is, I'm no technician) in this direction to protect WOWO. DXing is a fine hoboy! I'm only sorry I didn't stumble finto it years ago. Now this is no indiattion of a trend of time, since I kave only beor doing BCB (used to SWL only) for a year. However itt is a good example of the trend of verifications luring the past year. Since the beginning of thef year I: have sent outila reports and have been verified by 16 for a 76.2 \% average. Considering that 5 of my veries in this group have been received from a total of 7 Japanese stations, I could hardly complain. Since starting BCB work, I have - used a form recoption roport card. The above statistics show that it is successful in that I have received $50 \%$ letters and $76 \%$ replies all in one month. Hence, my theory. It is not the todis: we use, it is the manner in which we use them. A reception report card can be just as good a means of expressing our interest and know-how to a station as a letter. A thpage letter hastily written will reveal the verie-hingry BCBer just as easily as a hastily written form card. I have a space on all my cards for comients, wherein I always supply some parsonal touch to the report. To the recpption report letter advocate may I clarify myself in that 前 do use a letter in reporting to ary foreign country, or to any station which had a fluctuating signal, or when reception conditions were unordinary. Before I used my form card, I: sent samples of it to various old-timars in our hobby as vell as to the Elitor of the SWL column in Reaio News. The few mistakes which they found were corrected before I used them. To close my sermon, lot me say one. last thing. I think we are approaching the Verification problem from the wrong angle. We know just what the CEs want - a clear, honest, useful reception report, and knowledge that we, the senier, are just as interested in the stations success as to any of our own personal gain, such as the verification. If a letter, form card; or note scribbled on a matoh cover will fulfill these requirements then the report is a success...If we concentrate on improving the attitude of the reporter (which will always reveal itself in one way or another), rather than the form which he usas to report on, the situation will imediately be improved and solved within the not-toodistant future. 73's.
