Musings of the Members

Albert L. Stanton 128 Rattray St. Dunedin, N.Z.

I am typing this on 2/26, the hottest day this season with temp. 83 indoors. I have so many other interests now I don't do any DX except for North Americans, and then only in the height of the season. If anyone came close to challenging my position of BCB DX champion of N.Z. (nearest contender is over 300 stations behind) I might do some DX in the off season. We in N.Z. have the same difficulty as you with non-repliers. Out of 86 reports sent to N.A. for the 48-49 season 22 failed to reply even after a reminder, perhaps they don't believe they can be heard in N.Z. despite the proof I sent them. Broadcast Band varies now total 1270, 896 of which are for stations over 7000 miles from my set, probably the largest verified log in the world for this distance. Some say the East coast of N.Z. is a DXers paradise but believe me we have our locals every channel except 1520-1600 is occupied by a nearby Eastern Australia or a N.Z. station and U.S. allnighters such as KFEL 950, KXLA 1110, KRKD 1150, KSON 1240, KAGH 1300, KFAC 1330, KRUX 1340, KCBC 1390, KENO 1400, WNOE 1450, KWIK 1490, KXRX 1500, WCKY 1530, WPTR 1540, XERF 1570, XEMC 1590 and many others effectively block many of our best frequencies. Strangely enough, our summer from Nov to Feb is the best for N.A. reception whilst the winter is the best for the Asiatics and stations nearer at hand. N.A. are heard 8-10PM on tests and 10PM-3:30 AM for early AM s/ons. This season was not quite up to the standard of the previous one and it took on the average 3 hours at the set to log a new station-- yet there were thrills aplenty such as when WPAM announced frequently thru the KWCR special and two loggings were made without turning the dial. And when my LAST state of U.S. was logged at last with WDOV in Delaware opening up. (That's good DX up here too, ed) I had all the other states verified 8 years ago so its been a long wait. Other exceptional loggings were CJDC 1350, KFLY 1390, WWHG 1590, WTRF 1290, CKRM 980, WNDR 1260, WLOW 1410, WGIG 1440, WCPI 1420, WAFB 1460, WKXY 1540, WPKY 1580, WATO 1450. Total N.A. written to this season, 70, 19 being Calif. Its not uncommon thing to hear a dozen or more "Tone Tests" on the air at once and not one of them announcing. Wish the FCC would bring in a rule that every station give call every 15 minutes and at the start and end of each test-- we would treble our loggings. My receiver is a 10 tube Patterson which has been in constant use since 1935. Could do with a new one, but the British Empire is short of dollars and locally made stuff is not selective enough. I have four aeriels, two approx. N.N.E 1000 feet long and 10 feet high (Beveridge type) one S.W. to the top of a Pine tree fully 100 ft high, 40 ft high at house end and 225 ft long. and the other for Eastern and Australian stations due West, 45 ft high and 150' long. These are all situated 15½ miles from my city home at a seaside cottage, away from most of the city electrical interference. Its alright during the week, but the "weekenders" bring a certain amount of interference with them and make Saturday and Sunday DXing not so good. With regards to all who spend their time compiling "DX News" Isn't that DXing sompin. Imagine what we would think if our West Coast members should suddenly start complaining because New Zedders or Aussies were cluttering up the dial for them and preventing DXing, hmmm. Al would like to get a map of North America showing the time zones and the best map I can think of is the Conoco gas map of the United States which includes most of Canada. I have mine marked up with my 3 Western trips so am wondering if some of our Western members would step into their nearest Conoco gas station and pick one up. Send it direct if you wish -- or to P. D. North Girard Penna. and I'll forward it. Thanks.

I wish some of our more technically inclined members would explain the function of the "S" meter reading to me. I have always been of the impression that it was a relative measurement of antenna input, measured in terms of microvolts and arbitrarily scaled so that a maximum reading of S 9 would equal 100 microvolts. In order to provide a reading which has any relative value I should think it would be necessary for everyone to adjust (by means of the adjusting screw provided) his meter to read S 9 when tuned to his strongest local signal. I have done that on the Hammarlund and have never received a reading on any station other than the four locals as great as S 9. Is this procedure incorrect or what, as I have noticed numerous members reporting S 9 signals (some even speak of over S 9) on stations at great distances from their local area. Please lets have some comment on this. DX continues in a mid-winter slump here though some improvement has been noticed lately. The WTOR program ran into a mess on 1490 last Monday as WSIP held their FC and then came back on five minutes later for the rest of the morning. It was a marvelous program, plenty of publicity and dedications to members. If conditions were too bad I am sure DX Joe will run another for us later.
