That was a good question posed by Jeff. French regarding "S" ratings. There are sure to be some good argumnents over this one since there are probably as many opinions on the subject as there are DXers. First of ell, hovever, two points must be naie claar: l. The S-scale, as originsted by WZBSR in his R-S-T system of reporting, does not refer to actual values in microvolts. It mersly deseribes the signal received as follows: S-1 Faint, signals barely perceptible. S-2 Very weak signals. S-3. Weak signals. S-4 Fair signals. S-5 Fadrly good signals. S-6 Good signals, S-7 Moderately strons signala. S-8 Strong signals, and S-9 Extrenely strong signals. 2/ 中he relationship batween the input voltage of a signal to a receiver and the audible aimal at the output.end is not a straight line. That is to sey that a simal mith a 10 microvolt input loes not sound 10 times as strong as one with a 1 microvolt infut nor 5 times as strong as one with a 2 microvolt input, just like the signal from a 10 kw . station is not 100 times as strong as that received from a 100 watt station. The walue of the S-meter lies inf/its ability to make a more accurate measurement of signal strength at the input end of the receiver than in possible on the audible signal from the speaker or phones due to varying noise level. This, while an S-4 signal on a quiet morning will sound stronger th $n$ an $S-8$ signal over an S-6 noise level, the meter will show that the latter signal is actually a full S-8 and therefore give a truer picture of the signal received than is possible by the aar alone. In maiing comparison betwan input voltages and s-meter reaiings, I personally follow the correation which is given in the instmuction mawnal for my National "HRO." The manual reads as follows: "The S-raeter serves to indicate the strength of a received signal. It is calubrated from 1 to 9 in arbitrary unites which correspond to the definition of the 9 points of the "S" scale of the R-S-T syster. of ameteur sigmal reports. Probably no two operators will agree on just how strong a signal must be to warrant in S-9 raport. After making measurements on a large number of signals, the present meter scale was shoeen and we believe it will provide a good practical means of giving accurate reports. The accompanying curve shows the relation between the meter reading and the actual signal input to the receiver in microvolts." The curve referred to plots "S" unitws on a regular scals against mierovolts on'a logaritimic scecle. Starting at 0.2 microvolt as an inaudible, signal ( $\mathrm{S}-0$ ) an 0.5 microvolt signal hase a value of S-2; 1 microvolt, $S-4 \phi-2$ microvolts, $5-6 ; 5$ microvolts, S-8; and 8 microtolts, S-9. Dverything over 8 microvolts is S-9 plus. I have found that system works out quite well in actual praciice. Hope trat your re feeling OK by now, Lefty. : 73. "Thanks, Kerm, pretty chipper now - Ed.)
