In 10/26 DX NEWS I mentioned that the proposed station CHYM-1510 would be nothing more than a proposal. ERC commented the FCC already listed them as a new station. This is interesting, because the BBG hearing on the matter opened right around the deadline in Brooklyn, therefore the FCC infowould have been printed a while before that. In the U.S., a satisfactory application is approved. The FCC is ignorant of the fact that this isn't the case in Canada. Up here your wants for a CP are only approved of if there is a REAL need for a new station. The procedure here is not as liberal as in the States; most applications get the axe. Seabrooke-FCC list all Canadian "applications" as new CPs & have always been doing this. Will they ever acquire some eyesight? Toronto newspaperman Dennis Braithwaite is a real follower of the broadcasting industry. He's started objecting to governmental handling of BBG decisions. Before the present government got into power it was standard procedure to approve of all BBG decisions. Now the situation is starting to change, for example: CHFI-1540 wanted to go fulltime on 680 and would pay CHLO-680 \$175,000 to move to 1410. CKSL-1290 also wanted 1410. The CHFI/CHLO bid got the nod. Then the Transport Minister rejected the BBG decision & dropped a few hints that CKSL should get better treatment. CHLO, sensing a fix, withdrew its bid. Newsman Braithwaite did a bit of digging, concluded the reason for governmental action was the fact that CKSL's bigwigs are very good pals of the party in power, whereas CHFI owner Ted Rogers is fanatically attached to the Tory opposition. So now political considerations may override the BBG boys. How interesting. That little piece of news came from the 11/63 edition of "Canada Month" who loves neither the party in the driver's seat nor the opposition. 73.
