Hi all you lucky people - here I go again with another Musing. I DXed last 12/16 & logged two new stations & relogged two others. Was listening for the Special DX Test from KSCB & instead of getting them, I got a new one from Hawaii, KNDI-1270 @ 3:38-3:48 am. The other new one was KXRO-1320 @ 4:10am with s/off after an f/c. I relogged KGIL-1260 @ 3:19-3:28am at s/off. Also, WIBW-580 @ 4:05-4:06am. Letters have been sent to KNDI KGIL & KXRO with a f/up letter to WIBW. Veries have been coming in slowly but steadily. Veries from KTOO WLAC (after two months) KVLV KCBC & KXIV. Totals are now 270/160. Whoops, almost forgot. Verie in from Radio Americas. WX is finally starting to get cold. Temperatures have been around 30-45°. For all you ECers, that's 30-45° above zero, hi. DX has been improving, but all of a sudden I'm getting images, 54 images to be exact.
