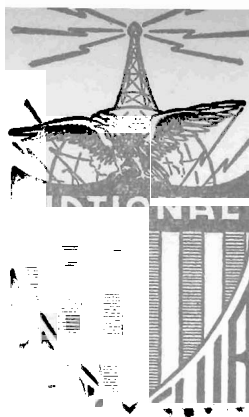

January is shaping up better. 1/4- 11pm, HRN-670; 10:15pm, YSS-655. 1/5- 9:30pm, YNOL-825; 10:40, TIW-775. 1/6- KBOI-950 gave NX @ 2am, then s/off without a word about sked NRC Special. KEYS-1440 Special in S-8, KFDA-1440 tested just ahead of KEYS. KVCV-600 Special not heard due to CFQC/KSLB. HNL eliminated WNOG-1270 & WCVI-1340. Have rebuilt Williams Loop so it now tilts as well as rotates. Tilting results in a more complete null in many cases, especially on locals. Also made timing device for tape recorder out of old electric clock. Records for five minutes only during hourly & half-hourly station breaks. Uses about 800' of tape per AN session at 1 1/8 IPS & plays back in about 1 1/4 hours during leisure hours the next evening. Getting a good night's sleep every night now except for occasional NMs. Now the big problem: Getting a location like Roy Millar or Len Lockwood.
