Veries, TIRICA for 1962, YVLT for 1962 DX, Sottens-764 (for country #69) WWSL WCVI WINV, but stationery says WINU - five veries in one mail - wonder of wonders! 1/20- WCHI-1340 at 2:15. WSEM-1500 f/c 2:16. WTHB-1550 f/c 2:20, TT. CFLV-1370 3:43, no sign of KNWC, needed here, all KIOX & Cuban. KIOX said now AN. WSBP-1580 test 3:56 for a new one here. Verie, KZOL on f/up with SAS, & WHAG.

Plunkett) noted anything stronger on 1540 just after 6pm, it was CHFI with about the weirdest test I've ever heard - how come they're allowed to test after their s/off at SSS? 12/31- CFNB-550 "Radio Atlantic" heard for first time this year & logged, 12:05-12:11 when KFJR overrode them; TT on 1520 bothering "KB" 12:28, off with no ID. Around 11pm, had an EE mixed in with WJR/CMCD on 760 - don't know who, as soon buried. 1/1- WTNS-1560 s/on 6:29; WRUN-1150 mixed with CKOC/WHUN, 6:47am; WLIJ-1580 logged prior to 6pm s/off. 1/2- First new catch of '64 was WHGR-1290 r/c, ID @ 12:30; WDAF-310 chopping up WIP; took a log on WPOP-1410, 12:40-12:48, as way on top. 1/3- CHUC first noted on 1450, not nearly as good signal here as when on 1500 - weaker, with QRM from WWGO; KNOE-540 booming in around 6pm; WESY-1580 s/off 6:14; ZNS-1540 terrific signal; got a log on WBSC-1550, 7:16-7:30 u/CBE - also SS heard briefly on 1550 7:20, Cuban? 1/4- KWA-960 s/off lam; log on WOLF-1490, 1:02-1:10. 1/5- Log on CKCW-1220, 1:05-1:15. CX were terrible - CKCW only station on 1220, but only barely readable. Log on WEDO-810 around 4:30pm; WBUC-1460 4:55, first time on RS but boomed in here on test last season; nice surprise to be able to log WHNC-890 so easily, with minimum WLS QRM; AFL FB on 970 u/WEBR, probably WJMX; WFLO-590 best signal ever, 5:30-5:40. What a coincidence! Lasy day before CKEY switch to 590 with NSP! Also, finally logged WNOE-1060 & KAAV-1090; new catch WLVN-1560, log 5:53-6pm s/off - WAGC-1560 noted under at times, didn't verify last year. Another new one here, WKRG-710, had channel almost to itself 6-6:10; who s/off on 1590 with Dixie, 6:17? WAKR spoiled ID. At 6:30, YVMH-700 had period of Italian songs; WQAI-560, log 6:32-6:42 - can't remember hearing them this time before, but all else on 560 blocked out; from 11:30-Mdt, CKEY had dual programming on 580 & 590 - what next! Off 590 just in time to allow log of WARM 11:55-Mdt s/off (easy catch but never logged before) & much harder, WROW-590 very briefly 12-12:01 s/off; strong TT on 1600 around 12:15 must have been CHVC; finally caught up with long needed WGL-1250 as CHWO off & only QRM from WRYT; CJBC off early & TT-860 from 12:50 till past 1, needed WEVA no doubt but no ID. WHB-710 weak u/WOR lam, O Canada-1410 1:03, is this CHLP, Andy? 73!

Totals: 332/860. Hope all enjoyed holidays - thanks for cards - school exams gave me no time for cards this year. Christmas was a mild 47° above here with dry streets. It's renewal* time again (* the best way to invest four bucks). KFQD Anchorage sent a new v/c to replace my PP, new "CBC Edmonton" QSL for three of my best catches: CBXE-730 CBXD-1110, CBXI-610 (all "weak" CBC relays), KGGM v/c, KROW KVOR WCWC v/1. CFWH Whitehorse sent "CBC Northern Service" QSL (picture of Eskimo carving & map) for CBDC-1230 40w. relay of CFWH, CBC NSP. Heard three times over KWXYZ AN with NX from CBU, & mx. CBU said Yukon relay - "no B.C. relay on 1230." This left CBDC Mayo & CFYT Dawson, 100w. (I believe CFYT is now only 40w. & may be CBDE). Our Eskimo Friend, Leo Fox, is looking into this, I hope. This is my Yukon #1 & rates as my BEST catch. Seems to me a lot of stuff is missed because it only has 40 or 50 watts & doesn't seem possible to log, like the CFSE DX - try 'em next time! How about CBLK-1090 (40w.) S-9 on the EC? For those quaint few who do have any of these relays verified, a question: "How would one QSL 20 NSP-CBC CBU/CBX relays all on 860 kc/s.? Most MMs here, any station has trouble breaking through the "Relay Jungle" on 860 which sometimes exists on 730, 900, & 740 kc/s. The only ID they have is "Ici Radio Canada. This is the CBC Radio Network," followed by just "CBX Alberta" or "This is CBU, CBUX, SW, & CBU-FM Vancouver and 43 low-powered relay XRs throughout B.C." No relay has any ID except one of these. Well, I found myself with a lam s/off & didn't have to get up till 6:15 this 1/20 AM, so thought I'd see what I could do without antenna. KWLA-1530 on r/c 1:15 to 1:20, good; WYLD-940 strong signal with ID every five minutes, & OC, must be the new 10kw. rig; KHOS under nearly perfectly readable with its K-Hoss c/w mx, unnn KXO-1230 noted at 2:06 s/off even with KNUZ, gave weekday sked as 8:30-2:05, Sunday 10-2:05, different Saturday, but failed to catch s/on; WTHB-1550 on r/c w/ID each minute, noted 2:23; KXIV-1400 logged on AN show 2:32-3:05, with QRM from Mexican which I'm almost certain was XEGD, Parral. No sign of the WANS DX with KNAK/WTCN (first time logged) atop. KBUB was testing on 1270 before & during the KNWC DX, latter on late (3:36) but good. QHMER on RS sounded like KIOX, but was extremely weak if it was. WITA-1140 s/on 3:52; station on 925 with "Cadena Musical" ID parallel to 675, assume Costa Rica, noted 4:03-4:10; ZFY-760 noted for first time at 4:11 s/on, but not good enough for log through VJR ET & Cuban problem; NIDL-1525 noted 4:20-4:34 with clock ticks, "Radio Pueblo" & gave address several times, but couldn't catch it. All this done without any antenna to the HQ-160, only a coil of 300 ohm TV leadin still inclosed in its packaged cardboard. The VJ log was picked up this weekend at an Amarillo electronics supply house, & it is utterly amazing in its up-to-dateness. I note that in the first 15 issues of DX NEWS this season, some 137 members have accounted for 449 Musings, but half the Musings, 223 were turned in by just 29 members. Fifty have contributed once, 22 twice, 17 three times, & 14 four times. John Johnson has been represented in 14 issues, Stan Morse & Ken Butterfield in 12, one in 11, one in nine, eight in eight issues, nine in seven, & three in six. "Information for NRC Members" - - - "From The NRC Governing Body"
- "Regarding Proposed Constitution & Bylaws drawn up at Denver Convention"

February 1 1964

Gentlemen;

As we start another New Year of Service to the DX Fraternity, We, The Publisher/Exec Sec., Musings Editor and IDXD Editor of the NRC would like to feel that we have your confidence and support as we endeavor to provide you with what we consider to be the finest BCB DX Publication available. During the past year and a half, both the organization of the NRC and certain individuals therein have been subjected to various complaints and conjecture, some of which have approached outright defamation, and many of which have been so ludicrous that a response of any kind would have been wasted effort.

The primary function of the NRC has been to furnish members with the latest in DX information and to do so with consistency and accuracy. To deny that this is being done would be untrue. The Club is set up organizationally for maximum efficiency on the part of responsible individuals, so that as much can get done as quickly as possible with as little intra-organization correspondence as necessary.

It has been suggested that for greater democracy, a larger operational organization be established, and this has been supported with elaborate Bylaws, which have been voted upon and approved by certain members of this past year's convention. We have rejected these Bylaws as we feel they are unwieldy and would result in general stagnation of the Club's administrative processes. We feel that a Non-Profit Club of this nature requires efficiency in lieu of being a Model Administrative Specimen. To support our objection to the Bylaws and to the way they have come about, we offer the following;

- (1) The fantastically juvenile methods used to gain support, and essentially to stir up the members during the opening stages of the smear campaign.
- (2) FRAUD, in that a document submitted to the Club Government for approval contained a forged signature.
- (3) FRAUD, in that the personnel signing the initial Bylaws approval were not all NRC Members and were therefore not eligible. This document was NOTARIZED.
- (4) The fact that evidence has arisen indicating projected use of funds collected at the Denver Convention was not clarified.
- (5) The fact that evidence has arisen indicating that signers of the Bylaws were given incomplete information as to the significance of their signature on the document.
- (6) FRAUD, in that the official vote count on the Bylaws contained names of people who are not members of the NRC and are therefore not eligible. This was NOTARIZED.
- (7) Even including the non-members in (6) above, the "ayes" for acceptance of the Bylaws do not constitute the required majority.

It is therefore our feeling that even disregarding (1) the poor taste and immaturity evidenced in many areas of this movement to change the Club Government; (2) the Fraud which has appeared through intention and/or neglect in at least Three instances; (3) The desire as evidenced in the Bylaws to transfer authority (but not responsibility) from those who are actually doing the work; and even disregarding (4) the strictly egotistical motivations behind the whole movement . . . the status of the solvent and as efficient as humanly possible NRC Government as it now stands should be maintained.
