On 2/14 around 11:15pm, was aimlessly tuning around for some interesting mx when I came upon local-like signal on 790. It was CHIC-790 (ex-1090) conducting ET prior to official start @ 12:01am on 2/15. I am only about ten miles from their XR & they are now much stronger with their 1,000/500 than they were with 250-D on 1090. RS hours were announced as 6am-1am & they ran 48-hour marathon & were AN 2/15 & 2/16 to celebrate. Also announced they are now using six 300' towers. Latest veries have been received from CFUN-1410 B.C. #3 & my second "CFUN" verified in two months. Other was of course, outlaw CFUN-1515 which expired about six weeks ago; rest of veries from WNIO-1540, one of the nicest I've got with engineer sketching directional day pattern (main lobes NE/SW) & mentioning hours in February as 7:15-6:00 & they went on the air 11/1; WCUB-980; WCLS-1580 with essential info that hours are 5am-midnight & nighttime pattern is NW/SE; v/c from KPRC-950 who operate from 5:45-2:00 EST; & oversize v/c from KmHL-1400 for f/c Their hours are 7-1am EST; finally from KFVS-960 with dandy Cms for both Am & TV. Their TV tower, incidentally, is one of the world's tallest structures at 1,676 feet. WTTN-1580 s/off 6:30; log on KKJO-1550 as dug out from 7-7:05. 2/7- KFVS-960 r/c ID @ 1:15; log on WJSO-1590 from 5:55-5:59 as WAKR very weak. 2/8- Got around to logging WGNV-1220, 5:25-5:30pm SSB s/off. 73.

Although I have not participated actively in the NRC's activities during my 14 years of membership & have only attended one Convention (White Plains) I know from observation that the paraphernalia of "democracy" are not essential to the running of the Club. Perhaps many do not remember when we used to have annual elections for directors & officers of the NRC. Despite the fact that Hal Williams contributed the postage-paid ballots, the participation on the part of the members was slight. Why? I think it was because members were satisfied with the jobs the editors & publisher were performing & were not concerned about superfluous committees & the other trappings of a formal organization. I do not foresee any real difference for the future. Infact, I suspect that the 151 people voting in the recent so-called election is not or is just barely a majority of Club members. Such splinter actions as we are now witnessing are highly detrimental to the hobby of BCB DXing. To start with, there are but a very few people in the world who are interested in the hobby. Secondly, in light of the increasing number of AN stations, the hobby is not likely to spread & will probably fall off in popularity. Thirdly, the personnel at radio stations are becoming progressively less interested in reception reports, so that ever-increasing co-operation between DXing organizations & the broadcasting personnel is required. Thus, rather than taking divisive action, all members should work to make the already-existing structures more functional. Instead of promising new features for the NRCI, the dissidents should have stayed with the Club as already established & offered these features to it. Co-operation is essential to the hobby, & such acts as "re-organizing" the NRC will accomplish nothing except to make a mockery of the hobby. I trust that the 98 members voting in favor of the so-called constitution will have enough sense to see how foolish such splintering action is & will remain with our NRC. Let us all recall the message of the house divided against itself. We must all stand together or we shall witness the premature death of the best BCB DX Club in the world.
