



FM and TV in the Derby City

FM and TV wise, Louisville is lucky and unlucky for the DXer. It's great because we're far enough from a large number of stations to have a fairly clear dial, but it's not so great because there are not too many regulars from large cities, as is the case in many large metro areas. The disadvantage means, to do any appreciable DX on FM-TV, you need a fair antenna for regular reception and while rabbit ears and a whip do work, the results are often disappointing.


