The station will repeat programming for all three days. This will give aircheck hounds a good opportunity to catch all the shifts. Shifts run from Mid-6AM, 6AM-10AM, 10AM-2PM, 2PM-6PM, and from 6PM to Midnight. News, weather, and sports are recorded daily.


