--- NOTES FROM CANADA ---

Monday, November 11 is Remembrance Day in Canada. Traditionally, radio stations have aired a minute of silence at 10:59 AM. The 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month in 1918 was the official end of World War I. Remembrance Day honors all Canadian armed forces members who have died in the line of duty.

The Canadian Association of Broadcasters will be operating the Commercial Radio News Fund (CRNF) to direct some of the fees levied by the CRTC on audio online undertakings in Canada to help commercial radio stations produce local News outside of Canada's major markets: Montreal, Toronto, Vancouver, Calgary, Edmonton and Ottawa-Gatineau. The CRTC is accepting comments on CRNF until December 4.

- 630 CHQT AB Edmonton – The engineering staff reported that the station, now off the air, had been running non-directional at night with lower power for the last few months after one of their aging towers had to be removed for safety reasons. (Scott Fybush)
- 1450 CBKA BC Stewart – Approved to move to FM as CBUI-FM on 98.1 MHz with a non-directional 202 Watts at 3,194 feet below the average (mountainous) terrain in the area (EHAAT). The new transmitter will continue to rebroadcast CFPR-860 Prince Rupert BC. Deadline for the move is November 7, 2026. (Andy Reid)
- 1610 CHHA ON Toronto – A question was raised on Facebook about the station's ownership given the CRTC's requirement that churches not own radio or television stations,



other than those Newfoundland stations already owned by a church when Newfoundland joined Canada in 1949. CHHA is not owned by the Catholic Church but by the San Lorenzo Latin American Community Centre, according to the CRTC.

--- U.S. STATION NEWS ---

- 1090 XEPRS **BCS Tijuana** – Has flipped the station to **Oldies**. The station will feature a lineup of well known personalities including Charlie Tuna, MG Kelly, El Chingon, Real Don Steele, and Wolfman Jack. The station will utilize Talent Farm's syndicated remasters of Wolfman Jack daily from 5-7pm. [Well, it's almost a U.S. station, hi – **BH**]
- 1180 KOFI **MT Kalispell – 11/13 2325** – No sign of their 30 Watts in first decent DX conditions since their November 9th transmitter fire. They hope to have a 1 kW transmitter on the air by the end of the year, but not back to 50/10 kW licensed powers until next summer. (**JP-AB**)

- 940 unID **-10/30 0059-0100** – Mentioning "RobinHood.com." QRM blocked the Call ID; KYNO Fresno trying to get through. I am certain this unID was in the southwestern United States. Clues? (**RA-CA**) [Why not KYNO?? Robinhood.com is a financial services company out of California – **BH**]

- 560 WHBQ **TN Memphis – 11/07 1826** – Ads, mention of "98.5 FM, basketball and football coverage." Unstable on caradio. Also later at **2159** on Sony with ads, ID WHBQ and Wxxxxx translator, into WW1 football. Now strong. (**EB-AL2**)
- 570 WKBN **OH Youngstown – 10/18 2258** – Poor, competing with WNAX. Ohio and Pennsylvania ads then TOH ID and I think into a baseball game; hard to tell for sure. (**MT-WI**)
- 570 WNAX **SD Yankton – 10/18 2300** – Poor, TOH ID then News mixing with a station carrying a baseball game. (**MT-WI**)
- 580 WIBW **KS Topeka – 11/06 0550** – Just an ID, works for me: "WIBW is your home for [...] football." Fair with fading. **New, for Kansas #02.** (**EB-AL2**)
- 580 WCHS **WV Charleston – 10/18 2259** – Fair, promo for morning news then TOH ID then High School Game Night with an interview with a football coach. (**MT-WI**)
- 590 WKZO **MI Kalamazoo – 10/18 2300** – Fair, Dave Ramsey ad cut abruptly to TOH ID then CBS News – Top Story Trump campaigning in Detroit. (**MT-WI**)
- 600 WMT **IA Cedar Rapids – 10/18 2300** – Poor, buried by KSJB, Dave Ramsey ad then TOH ID able to hear "Cedar Rapids," News after ID. (**MT-WI**)
- 600 WCVB **NC Murphy – 11/06 0556** – Oldies, and ID "WCVB AM"; Trump news. Fair, with fading, likely already on day power. **New, for North Carolina #06.** (**EB-AL2**)
- 600 KSJB **ND Jamestown – 10/18 2258** – Fair, Prep Sports Roundup mentioning call letters. Another station under, but KSJB too overpowering. (**MT-WI**)
- 610 WTVN **OH Columbus – 10/18 2300** – Poor, TOH ID then ABC News swamped by KDAL. (**MT-WI**)
- 620 WTMJ **WI Milwaukee – 10/18 2300** – Good, TOH ID for WTLX then Wisconsin Badgers Volleyball post game show followed by ads then ABC News then promo for Milwaukee traffic reports mentioning WTMJ but no actual traffic report. Going into some call-in show in progress. No actual ID heard. (**MT-WI**)

Only second station ever heard here on 630, fulfilling my prediction of what I would hear as I planned for my local on 630 to go off the air by staring at Night Patterns of stations on 630. Since then, WREY is my most frequently heard 630 station. Formerly, KDWB, named after KFWB in Los Angeles as Chuck Blore expanded the Color Radio Channel Top 40 format into other markets. (JP-AB)

- 730 WZGV NC Cramerton – 11/13 0744 – Poor, though steady. Sports chatter. ESPN “Game” slogan. Alone. **Again in on 11/15 @ 0744** – Poor – hyped up, caffeinated Sports talk: ESPN, ESPN promo after promo. (JJR-WI)



- 730 WJMT WI Merrill – 11/5 0712 – “. . . told WJMT news” and Lincoln County mentions, in newscast. Poor, with little CKDM. (JJR-WI)

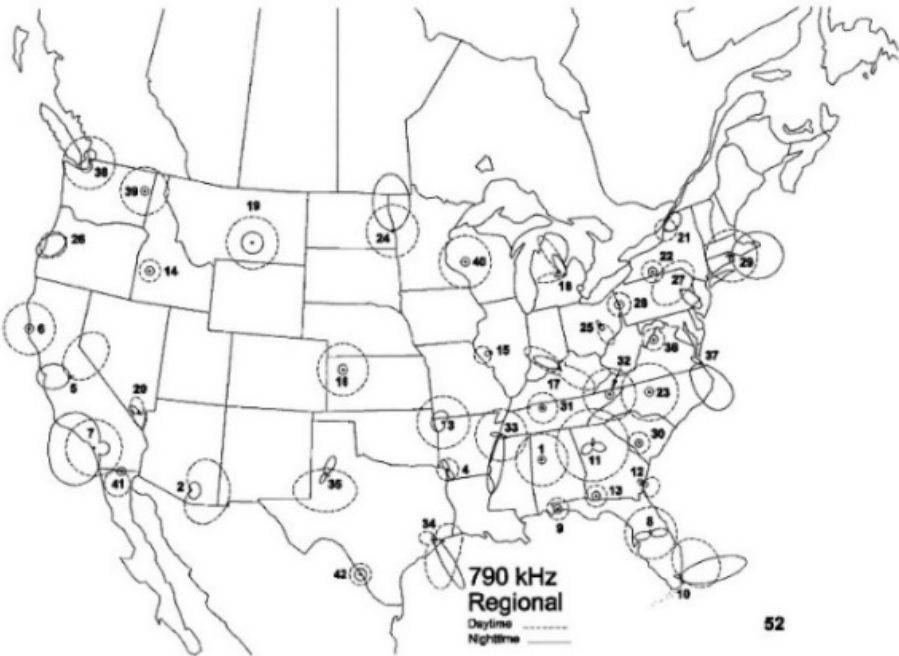

Been away from BCB for a while. In January 2023 I jumped into the ARRL Amateur Radio "Volunteers on the Air" (VOTA) all band, all mode contest and finally came up for air when it ended in January 2024. Took a breather and then eased on 6 meters. Now that it is autumn, I've fired up the SDRPlay RSPdx and the SDRUno software and started some overnight recordings. My first overnight taping session was 10/17. The dial has changed somewhat in a year and first off I'm getting used to who is dominant on which channel on which antenna. The E/W Flag on the back fence is still functioning and my Wellbrook loop and rotor are still working fine as well. I've started my annual log where I keep track of the stations I've heard each year. I'm at 288 so far. I got about 50 just doing daytime DX. Highlights included local ID tapes of KJME-780 (ex-KCEG), a new station since the move to Fountain from Pueblo; KCEG-890 (ex-KJME) and KFBU-1630 (ex-KVAM) needed local call changes. These two appeared to have been powering up to daytime power. 10/19 Saw a call change from KSGO-1450 (ex-KZNU) and a new one in KSKK-1070 audible just on the low side of the channel. Jon Pearkins, Edmonton AB

KOFI-1180 Kalispell MT went off the air at 0513 EST on November 9 after the entire contents of their transmitter building was destroyed by fire. The ATU (Antenna Tuning Unit) and towers were not damaged, so their Chief Engineer was able to get them back on the air with 30 watts the next day, allowing their FM Translator to operate continuously without violating FCC regulations. They hope to have a 1KW transmitter up and running before year end but it will be next summer before they are running their normal 50KW day/10KW night.

When DX conditions finally improved enough to pick up some other stations on 1180, I was able to hear WHAM in Rochester NY, one of the stations on my DX Bucket List. In the past, all I have ever heard while nulling KOFI has been a Cuban station, so I suspect that the recent earthquake and

hurricanes have silenced many Cuban stations, including those on 1180; it has been a while since I've heard a regular here, CMBQ-530, so I suspect it is also not currently on the air.

Before KOFI moved from 930 to 1180 in 1968, WHAM was regularly heard in Vancouver. Local DXers called it "Wham" even though the station never referred to itself that way on the air. Back then, the late DXer Paul Lotsof from Buffalo sent me a recording of the station when it was simulcasting on its FM station, and the identification was different than I had heard it from Vancouver. The top of the hour ID was "WH-AM and WH-FM Rochester, New York," rather than the usual "W-H-A-M" I had heard in Vancouver. Today, the original WHFM-FM is WBZA-FM and the WHFM call letters ended up on the former WWRJ-FM in Southampton NY.

RadioJayAllen is a web site where one well-respected broadcast engineer reviews the AM and FM performance of portable radios. Even if you are familiar with the site, his new Quick Shopping Guide provides a nice summary of his Picks in various categories at <https://radiojayallen.com/holiday-shopping-guide-jays-personal-picks-for-performance-and-value/>

Jay also reviews the new Tecsun S-2200X. It costs a lot more and is a lot bigger than the Qodosen DX-286 but it has some additional features that really appeal to me. Most notably the ability to listen to either the Upper or Lower Sideband, which is a great way to listen to adjacent frequencies to powerful locals. Unfortunately, it will be a while before it is easily available, especially to those of us in Canada.

I spent quite a bit of time going over the IQ recordings I made while in CO in October and found another 9 new stations in addition to the 17 I reported in the previous Domestic DX West column. Happily, I was able to log KOFI and record the ID before they went off the air as Jon Pearkins reported in his musing.

I used a few of the CO IQ recordings to test out the SDR# AM Co-Channel Canceller, but even when I was able to eliminate the carrier on several of the locals, I didn't find other stations underneath. As I've discussed here before, I prefer SDR Console for recording and playing IQ files. I found using SDR Console's SAM, ECSS-L and ECSS-U modes with various filter widths and the adjustable gain control in the playback section, it wasn't difficult to pull out stations from under one another or to eliminate splash from adjacent frequencies. I'm curious if others have suggestions and comments about their preferred methods of digging stations out.



Unreported Stations

One more stations – WBTH-1400 – was reported to DDXD in this issue for the first time since at least Volume 67 (1999-2000). We now have only 163 currently licensed, full-power AM stations in the United States and Canada which have not been reported to DDXD during this time. The last full list was published in issue 91-18 in July and electronically in *DXtra News* in September.
