From the Archives

90 Years Ago: The May 1935 issue of *DX News* seems to be missing from the archive.

75 Years Ago: From the May 20, 1950 issue of *DX News*: Sixty members donated funds to purchase a new mimeograph machine for printing *DX News*. Bernie Duffy of Staten Island, N.Y. reported that the prior season was one of the best in his 22 years of DXing; highlights included LKS Norway, PRE-4 Brazil, and KHON Honolulu.

50 Years Ago: From the May 27, 1975 issue of *DX News*: C.W. Bailey published a summary of trans-Atlantic observations from Holden, Massachusetts on 324 nights (all but 5 of which had at least some TA signals) over the 13 months from March 1974-March 1975, including 135 receptions of Sinkiang, China on 1525 kHz. Russ Edmunds collected a number of reactions, positive and negative, responding to the recent review of the Dymek DA-3 antenna.

25 Years Ago: From the June 12, 2000 issue of *DX News*: Bruce Conti announced a “Longest Day of the Year DX Challenge” contest for DXing on June 21. Bill Hepburn published remembrances of DXing in the High Arctic (what is now Nunavut) in 1982-1985, including a bandscan from Eureka (80 degrees North, population 9, 11 in summer). Gerry Thomas reviewed the Palstar R30 general coverage receiver.

10 Years Ago: From the April 27, 2015 issue of *DX News*: The NRC’s DX Audio Service published its final edition in April.

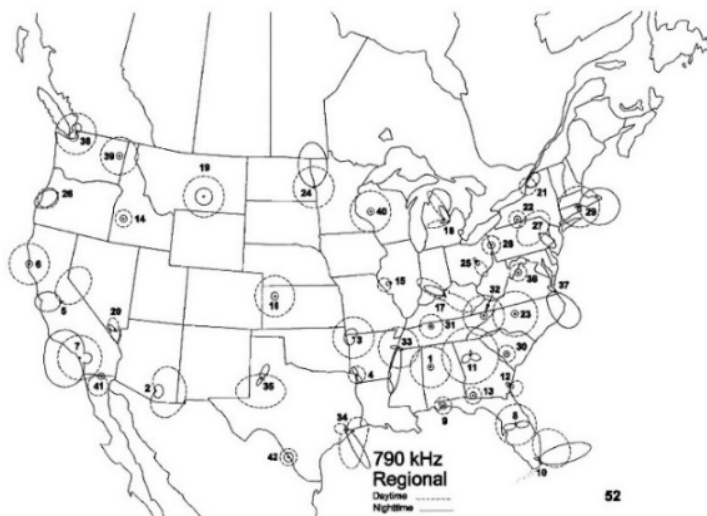

Vista has taken full control of the Bell stations that they purchased in British Columbia, and none of the stations have changed format. All the AM stations are listed below. Most of them now use the 'Summit' branding that were formerly branded 'Bounce,' as Bell retained the 'Bounce' brand. Based on the new Vista station logos and web sites, the original press release and DXer reports, the 'Summit' branding appears to vary slightly from station-to-station depending on the frequency, used before or after "Summit," and whether AM is mentioned.

- 580 CHAH AB Edmonton – 4/27 0010-0013 – Open Carrier from when tuned in until 0013. Second time Open Carrier heard at beginning of same 0000-0100 Chinese language programming block. Also . . . noticed twice recently with 5-10 minutes of Open Carrier at the beginning of the 0001-0100 weeknight Chinese-language programming block. This station is worth watching by those where CHAH is dominant on 580. (JP-AB)
- 590 CFTK BC Terrace – Switched branding to 'Summit.'
- 630 CFCO ON Chatham – Has been approved to move to FM on 91.3 MHz with 1250 Watts non-directional from a height of 435 feet above average terrain. The customary three-month simulcast period has been made mandatory – area station that I could not hear in awful conditions, presumably indicating they were off the air.
- 700 CJLI AB Calgary – 5/5 2345 & 0020 – Was the only Calgary area station that I could not hear in awful conditions, presumably indicating they were off the air. (JP-AB)
- 800 CKOR BC Penticton – Has switched their branding to 'Summit.' Noted overnight April 29-30 on their 10 kW non-directional day pattern.
- 870 CKIR BC Invermere – Has switched their branding to 'Summit.' Any mention of the frequency will be "106.3" and call letter IDs will be "CKGR-FM," as they rebroadcast CKGR-FM 106.3, Golden, BC.

Unreported Stations

No fewer than three stations were reported to DDXD in this issue for the first time since at least Volume 67 (1999-2000) – WLVA-580, WFUZ-1240, and (albeit tentatively) WJKN-1510. In addition, now that WWTM has moved to 1390, we’ll add them to the unreported list on their new frequency. So that means we have only 153 currently licensed, full-power AM stations in the United States and Canada which have not been reported to DDXD during this time.

The last full list was published in issue 91-18 last July and has been updated electronically a couple of times since in *DXtra News*. Can you report one next time?

- 1476 unID MAY 5 0357 – JJBBA carrier, only 9/kHz TA one in careful full MW bandscan direct, surely TWR Benin, with its low-latitude advantage, per MWlist from 0320 M-F in Hausa, 150 to 200 kW. I wonder if it be directional favoring Nigeria, disfavoring us. [Hauser-OK]

PAN-AMERICAN DX

- 610 **MEXICO** XECCBS *La Q*, Fresnillo, Zac. MAY 9 0200 – New station on air with ranchera music(?) and full ID mentioning 10 kW. Good signal, but not consistent enough to verify its schedule. [Jeziorski-QRO]
- 630.05 unID MAY 5 0406 – Low audible het (LAH) against 630.0 stations. MWoffsets has nothing further off than 630.006 kHz. MAY 11 0609 – JBA het to 630.00 stations. KHOW Denver had been reported offset plus but not that much. Tim Hall: “For what it’s worth, KHOW was operating around 630.019 the entire weekend of my Nevada-Utah border DXpedition last October.” Next time I should try to DF it. MAY 12 0635 – Het upon 630.00 stations. This time I do DF it on the hand-held DX-398 to find it nulling at WNW/ESE so that means it’s SSW/NNE, ruling out KHOW. Most likely XEFB Monterrey NL, or maybe XEPBGJ Guadalajara, by direction but supposed to be daytimer. Otherwise, WREY St. Paul MN, which is Spanish, ‘El Rey’. [Hauser-OK]
- 660.83 unID APR 28 0252 – JBA carrier hetting 660.0 stations. Local or DX? [Hauser-OK]
- 670 **CUBA** *R.Rebelde*, multiple locations MAY 5 0403 – No WSCR Chicago! Rather Cuban music, but WSCR may be on with open carrier. Meanwhile, 720 WGN and 780 WBBM are very good as usual. At 0409 also audible a very weak station in English, could be KLTT or KBOI. By 0607 recheck, WSCR has resumed modulating sports talk. [Hauser-OK]
- 770 **COLOMBIA** HJJX, RCN, Bogotá MAY 9 0100 – “RCN” heard during possible sports broadcast; fair. [Jeziorski-QRO]
- 771 unID APR 28 0247 – JBA carrier making het with 770.0, KKOB or whatever. Another Cuban anomaly, like 1141 kHz? [Hauser-OK]
- 780 **MEXICO** XEGLO *La Voz de la Sierra Juárez*, Guelatao de Juárez, Oax. MAY 9 0800 – Good with music and slogan. This indigenous station normally has a 1200-0000 schedule, but sometimes leaves the AM on during night hours to simulcast the FM. [Jeziorski-QRO]
- 800 **MEXICO** XEERG, *RG La Deportiva*, Ojo de Agua, NL MAY 9 0600 – Presumed with Mexican national anthem. ID not heard, but the terrible modulation noted in recent months may have been addressed at least partially. [Jeziorski-QRO] MAY 11 0612 – KQCV in the clear, no extremely distorted co-channel interference, and not noted for several nights now, so maybe XEERG has finally been fixed or deleted! [Hauser-OK]
- 870 **CUBA** *R.Reloj*, multiple locations MAY 8 0645 – Occasional bits of wobbling under WWL. [Hauser-OK]
- 1020 **MEXICO** XEPR, *FM Globo*, Poza Rica, Ver. MAY 4 – Previously active station not heard while visiting the city of Poza Rica; local listeners say it is broadcasting intermittently. [Jeziorski-VER]
- 1040 **CUBA** *R.Mayabeque*, Güines MAY 5 0401 – Wobbler beneath WHO, only one currently audible. [Hauser-OK]
- 1110 **MEXICO** XERED *Radio Red*, México, CMDX MAY 18 0600 – Poor; choral national anthem. [Conti-NH]
- 1130 **VENEZUELA** YVRL *R.Ideal*, Maiquetía MAY 18 0800 – Fair with WBBR cancelled; religious talk in Spanish with palabra, señor, and Venezuela mentions. [Conti-NH]
- 1250 **MEXICO** XEVREP *Arre en AcustiK*, Veracruz, Ver. MAY 3 – Previously active station not heard while visiting the city of Veracruz; local listeners say it is broadcasting intermittently. [Jeziorski-VER]
- 1290 **MEXICO** XECCBU *Salvatierra*, Gto. APR 8 0325 – Heard with Mexican music and full ID that included “señal de prueba” (test signal), but not heard in May at a distance of 43 miles. [Jeziorski-QRO]



- 1300 **MEXICO** XECPAD *Radio UV*, Xalapa, Ver. MAY 2 – Previously active station not heard while visiting the city of Xalapa (possible open carrier caught by car radio scan); local listeners say it is broadcasting intermittently. [Jeziorski-VER]
- 1310 **MEXICO** XEQRMD, *W Radio*, Querétaro, Qro. MAY 1 1500 – After more than three years silent, my local station has returned to air, again with a poor signal given its proximity. Local listeners report that it maintains a mostly daytime schedule. [Jeziorski-QRO]
- 1549.8 unID MAY 5 0359 – JBA het against 1550.0 signals. In the May 12 edition of *ARC mv-eko*, Fredrik Dourén logged OAM5M *R.Visión*, Pisco, Peru at 1549.820 kHz, and Jan Edh reported Peru at 1549.819 kHz, closely matching the unID I have been hearing and thought to be much closer XEREL in Morelia, Mexico! However WRTH 2025 and mwlist show hours of 3 kW OAM5M are 1100-0205 UTC while I have been hearing that later overnight. Pisco is right near the coast south of Lima. More like south/southeast from here than Morelia south/southwest. I need to DF it again. [Hauser-OK]
- 1550 **CUBA** *R.Rebelde*, Cienfuegos MAY 18 0800 – Poor; offset frequency measured 1549.987 kHz listed as Cienfuegos, the lowest offset signal observed here. Calibration checked against 1550.000 CBEF. [Conti-NH]
- 1570 **MEXICO** XERF Cd. Acuña, Coah. APR 30 0536 – Female Spanish voice marking the first time heard in over a year, which is not surprising given how dreadful the DX conditions have been most nights. Initially noted with signs of KBCV Hollister but they disappeared almost immediately. [Pearkins-AB]
- 1610 unID MAY 11 0621 – Dead air at s9+, suspected CHHA Toronto, the only North American on this ‘clear’ channel – except for HAR/TIS: hundreds of them listed, almost all 10 watts, including three in Oklahoma: OKC, Davis and Jet – the latter has been gone for a few years. Listening further, a trace of modulation, interference or CHHA? In South America there is one 1610 in Argentina +3 inactives, and two in Perú, all low-power. [Hauser-OK]

TRANS-PACIFIC DX

- 846 **KIRIBATI** *R.Kiribati*, London, Christmas Island MAY 3 0630 – JJBBB carrier. Almost every night I check for signs of *R.Kiribati* reactivated, which used to be regularly detectable, since it’s on a ‘clear’ split and very far east, same longitude as Hawaii. This is so weak that I am far from sure it’s not a spoiler birdie. Ron Howard: “Checked May 4, a few times after 0445+ and heard nothing on 846, via several NZ remotes; was a clear frequency.” [Hauser-OK]

- 1134 *RNZ National*, Queenstown, has closed its AM frequency and now operates on FM.
- 1449 *RNZ National*, Palmerston North, has closed its AM frequency and now operates on FM.

Also, all **SENZ** stations now identify as *Sport Nation* and all *Star* stations now identify as *Sanctuary*. The format of each respective network remain sport and religious programming. Thanks to *Radio*

The mention of CJAT-FM in last issue's Domestic DX Digest - West, as the station that CFKC-1340 Creston BC rebroadcasts, brought back memories of my first paid on-air announcing job. It too was at CJAT-FM in Trail BC, though not technically the same station. The current station resulted from the 1994 flip of CJAT-610 to FM. The CJAT-FM where I worked is now CBTA-FM, a rebroadcaster of CBC Kelowna's CBTK-FM. Then, as now, 13,500 watts from the top of Red Mountain, North of Rossland.

Back in 1972, when I was there, Management told me that CJAT-FM had more listeners in Spokane WA than in Trail, thanks to its mountain top transmitter location and power. It was also carried on Cable FM in both Edmonton and Calgary AB. All of which meant that weather reports on the station were rather lengthy, covering Calgary, Edmonton, Spokane and, of course, the East Kootenays, which includes Trail. It was good practice for my later work reading long weather forecasts at CFPR-860 Prince Rupert BC and CFYK-1340 Yellowknife NWT, as both stations had over a dozen CBC LPRTs spread across a large area.

Although larger markets were no longer allowed, as of September 1, 1971, to AM-FM simulcast, Trail was a small one-station market, and 50% simulcasting was still allowed. On weekdays, CJAT-FM simulcast CJAT-AM for the 6-7 PM CBC network News/Information hour, and from sign-on until 2:00 pm. In all Canadian markets, AM-FM simulcasting was still allowed from midnight to 6:00 AM, as the CRTC did not consider that part of the Broadcast Week.

Despite a lower hourly wage, \$1.75/hour minimum wage versus the \$2.50/hour that I had been making at CHQM, I still made more at CJAT than I would have at CHQM where 28 hours/week was the maximum they allowed part-time Operators like me to work. CJAT paid me for 40 hours on-air per week, spread across six days, with Prep Time on my own time, and doing my own hourly Newscasts. It sounds like a lot of hours, but CHQM's full-time Operators worked 46 hour weeks, which was the maximum then legally allowed without overtime pay.



At CJAT, Sunday was my toughest shift, 6:00 pm to 1:15 am signoff, with the first six hours all alone in the station, running separate programming on AM and FM. No automation and no voice tracks with all music on vinyl. Admittedly, 10:35 PM to midnight on AM was a CBC network program, with the rest of the shift a Top 40 format. FM was a combination of pre-recorded and live CBC network programming, with 30 second live local breaks. The only true conflict was a 30 second break on FM during a five minute Newscast on AM.

The midnight to 1:10 AM AM-FM simulcast was the highlight of the week. I could play what I wanted to as Management was already in bed in preparation for the long workweek ahead. I also added a five minute segment to the 1:00 AM News that I compiled from the huge amount of material on the "Weird" peg in the Newsroom where the week's weird stories were placed, as they came in on the Broadcast News teletype. Stories like the multi-billion dollar proposal for a high speed subway from Los Angeles to New York City, using Magnetic Levitation, which was both environmentally

friendly and exceedingly inexpensive. Or the details of the briefcase that accompanied President Nixon wherever he went, so that he had access to the Nuclear Codes should the need arise.

I didn't think about it at the time, but some stations on 610 still went off the air for transmitter maintenance at midnight Sunday nights. As a result, the only known aircheck of me on CJAT-AM was recorded by a DX'er in Seattle. Listening to it again fairly recently, I discovered two interesting facts. Every time that I opened the microphone switch, I was seriously overmodulating, thanks to my ill-advised technique to talking across the Cardioid microphone, which boosted the bass in my voice. CJAT's AM audio compressor was primitive, monitoring the audio level at a single audio frequency, probably 1000 Hz. On the positive side, that recording surprised me with my flawless delivery after more than seven hours on the air, including six hours of running two separately programmed stations.

At my next job, and my all-time favorite job, at CFPR in Prince Rupert BC, I once mentioned to someone that this one hour was my favorite of the week. Next thing I know, everyone at CFPR thought I had been only on the air one hour a week at CJAT. The Grapevine is like that. I later found out that everyone thought I was an American Draft Dodger because my Vancouver accent sounded to Prince Rupert residents like I was from the U.S.

A friend at CJAT lent me a radio. First thing I did that night, was to tune it to CHQM and suddenly feel very, very homesick, as I wondered which of my former CHQM co-workers were operating the voice tracks that evening.

FCC Construction Permits

At this time, the FCC is only accepting applications for “minor modification” CPs from currently licensed stations. This means that the new facilities, when built, would overlap sufficiently with the already-licensed facilities that both could not be authorized simultaneously. This allows for frequency

moves of up to 30 kHz (but not more), as well as geographical moves within the coverage overlap area.

The FCC also requires a CP for corrections to a station’s geographical coordinates of at least 3 seconds of latitude or longitude, even if no actual “construction” will take place.

With the FCC’s transition to the new Licensing and Management System (LMS) for processing station applications, including for CPs as of mid-2023, coordinates are given in the “NAD83” reference system (to the nearest tenth of a second). Older applications and authorizations are in the “NAD27” system (to the nearest second), and the coordinates of any given station in the two systems may vary by a couple of seconds, especially in longitude. Coordinates below in the format “40-00-00.0, 80-00-00.0” are NAD83 and in the format “40-00-00/80-00-00” are NAD27. All latitudes are North and all longitudes are West, unless otherwise specified.

Once the CP is substantially built, the station applies for a “license to cover” (LTC) the CP, containing data about the actual operation of the constructed facilities. In most cases stations that have submitted an LTC application will use the CP facilities on the air under “program test authority.” If the station does not file for an LTC within 3 years of the grant of a CP, the CP expires and the station must reapply for a new CP if it wishes to proceed with the project.
