
We thank you for your excellent reception report. We have listened to the tape and are amazed with the clarity and strength of CHOK at such a distance. On January 3rd at 5:33 P.M. we were operating on our night-time pattern which avoids your area. We also noted that the Charlottesville station and Indianapolis were quite garbled by comparison. Also were impressed by your letterhead which boldly states: You've Been Heard in Virginia, U.S.A.!!!

This then will confirm that we have checked our log for that date and find your report to be correct.

For your information, CHOK broadcasts 24 hours a day and operates on a day and night-time power of 10,000 Watts. The day-time pattern is circular with a slight bulge to the Northeast. The night-time pattern is similar with slight restrictions to the Southeast and Southwest.

Feeling that you might be interested in the area in which we are located, we have attached material provided by the Sarnia and District Chamber of Commerce.
