Many thanks for the fine reception report! I am pleased to VERIFY your reception of CKJD-1110 on Sunday morning February 26th, 1978 at 00:23 EST. The details in your report were entirely correct. At the time of your reception CKJD was operating at 1000 watts into the nighttime array. Our new 12 tower transmitter site is located 11 miles south of Sarnia. I have received quite a few reports since CKJD switched to 1110 KHz, all of them from the east, two others have reported from Virginia: Alan Merriman, Fairfax VA, and John Tweedie, Accomac VA. Virginia is as far south as I've had reported so far. The old 1250 - CKJD made it as far south as the gulf of Mexico a couple of times, and once to Finland!
