

CKKW, 1090 KHz,,Class II, DA - 2, 10,000 Watts, from a site 2 miles East of AYR, ONTARIO. Four towers day pattern, nine towers night pattern. Programming is continuous. Operation began March 5, 1975 at 5:15 PM.



CKCO - TV transmits on Channel 13 with an omnidirectional pattern from an effective height above ground of 956 feet. Picture power is 325,000 watts. Sound power is 65,000 watts. The site is located at Baden, Ontario.

CKCO - TV also transmits on Channel 2 with an omni-directional pattern from an effective height above ground of 943 feet. Picture power is 100,000 watts. Sound power is 13,500 watts. The site is located at Barrow Bay, just north of Wiarton, Ontario. Channel 2 serves the Georgian Bay area of Ontario.

CKCO - TV also transmits on UHF Channel 42 with an omni - directional pattern from an effective height above ground of 985 feet. Picture power is 1,752,000 watts. Sound power is 175,200 watts. The site is located at Oil Springs, Ontario and screes the south western area of Ontario including Chatham/Sarnia.



CFCA Stereo transmits on 105.3 MHz with a horizontal signal of 100,000 watts as well as a vertical signal of 100,000 watts. The transmitter site is also at Baden, Ontario with an effective height above ground of 812 feet.
