Thank you for your reception report of January 2, 1979. We are pleased to report that it was indeed WRHC that you were listening to. Our transmitter is located in Biscayne Bay, one of a handfull of stations in the nation to use an offshore site. The reason for this, in our case, is that our directional pattern is set up to reject the Bahamas Islands yet deliver a strong signal throughout the south Florida population center. The reason we prevent our signal from carrying into the Bahamas is that by NARBA agreement, the Bahamas operate a clear channel station (ZNS-1) on 1540khz. I wish to thank you for the material you sent me from the National Radio Club. Although my interests have drifted away from medium wave DX'ing, it was a favorite hobby of mine as a youth.
