Dear Sirs:

This letter is to report my reception of WPGF-FM on April 23, 1967 at 2214 EST. This is not my first logging of your FM outlet, but it is the first time I have heard you at such a strong level. At the time of my logging, WPGF was putting in a fair to good signal with only light fading. There was no QRM from other stations. Usually WPGF-FM is received at a low signal level and fading in and out. However, on April 23, FM signals were coming in well from the coast and the Piedmont area and also from Virginia.
