Dear Mr. Andrews,

This is to verify your reception report for ZIZ Radio on Monday, October 10, 1977, on 555 KHZ A.M. at 8.45 p.m. our time. Thank you very much for it.

I am happy to inform you that the contents of your letter of October 13, 1977, and of the tape recording you enclosed, conform with our programme log for Monday, October 10, 1977. Our radiated power is twenty thousand Watts (20,000 W), but on the day in question, we were running at ten thousand Watts (10,000 W). We use a conventional three hundred foot (300ft) Mast Radiator, with ground system consisting of one hundred and twenty (120) radials, quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) wavelength long.

We shall be grateful if we could have another report from you when we are on twenty thousand Watts (20,000 W), for which we shall communicate with you further.
