Dear Kelly:

Thank you for your reception report of WMIX! This verifies your reception of WMIX on 940 kHz on Monday morning, October 25th, from 0243 to 0255 a.m. EDT.

We've been receiving reception reports from North Carolina, Virginia, Maryland, and Pennsylvania to the east and Nebraska, Missouri and Colorado to the west since our 500-watt transmitter went on the air, and we extended our schedule from 6 a.m. to sunset to 24 hours NSP.

Yes, it's 500 watts, but because of the severe nulls to the north and to the south, most of the actual energy is directed east and west ... therefore you get probably somewhere in the neighborhood of 980 watts or so. That's only a guesstimate ... I haven't worked out the math.

I'm enclosing for your information a daytime coverage map and a night-time pattern calculation.
