This will confirm your reception of WJPS on 1330 kc at 0058 EST on July 16, 1966. A check of our logs confirms that it was indeed WJPS that you received.


WJPS broadcasts with 5000 watts during daylight hours and 1000 watts for the remainder of our hours from 5 AM to 1 AM local time. On the reverse side is a coverage map showing the 2 mv/m daytime and 6.8 mv/m (interference free) contours. We use three $\frac{1}{4}$ wave towers in our night-time pattern and 2 of these towers during the day. At present we have an application on file for non-directional daytime operation.

WJPS began broadcasting on October 3, 1947, and is presently operating on a Top 40 music format 20 hours a day, except Sunday, when we broadcast from 7 AM to 12 midnight.
