For QSL, WREN is a 5 KW DA-N station, operating on an assigned frequency of 1250 KHz. Operation during daylight hours is with a single 1/2 wave vertical antenna with an omni-directional pattern. Operation from sunset to sunrise is with a four (4) tower directional array with the single major lobe at a bearing of 253 degrees from true north. The station's 5 mv/m contour covers an eight state area to the west during directional operation.
