Dear Kelly:

We are very pleased to receive your QSL of February 9, 1976, from 12:29am to 1:30am.

WDEE is a class IIB station operating on 1500 KHz, a clear channel with the class IB stations KSTP and WTOP. We operate at 50 KW with nine towers during the day and 5 KW with twelve towers at night.

In answer to your question about the WJBK/WDEE arrangement, Storer Broadcasting changed the call letters to WDEE, The Big "D", in 1969. The station was then sold to Globetrotter Communications, Inc. in 1973. Thus, it is essentially the same operation.
