Dear Mr. Andrews;

Please accept this letter for verification of your reception report of December 29, 1975 of WMVB Am. The details of the report proved to be true and accurate for the time period of 6:00 am to 6:15 am.

WMVB AM is a directional daytime only station licensed for 1000 watts day and 500 watts presunrise power, which by the way we were using at the time of your report. We use a Raytheon RA-1000 AM transmitter, loaded into a two tower directional antenna with a Gates phasing and tuning networks. Out towers are a quarter wavelength (two hundred feet) in height, and 90° (200 feet) apart).

WMVB also operates an FM on 97.3 with an effective radiated power of 5.7kw. There we use an ITA FM 1000 C transmitter with a Wilkenson FM 10E exciter and a seven bay Jampro antenna.

Thank you for taking the time to write and tell us you heard us. To my knowledge you are our most distant listener. Some time you are in the area, please feel free to stop and visit the station. Studios and transmitters are located on Lincoln Avenue in South Vineland, New Jersey.
