We are pleased to confirm your reception of WLOS-TV-
AM-FM on June 17 1967, at 0030 E.D.T.

Thank you for your report, which is of interest to
our Engineering Department.

WLOS-AM is located at Emma, N. C., and at the time of
your reception was operating with non-directional antenna,
 182' towers, and a power of watts.

Our TV and FM transmitting facilities are located atop
mile high Mount Pisgah, 18 miles from Asheville. The TV
operates with a power of 170,000 watts, and the FM with
27,000 watts. Programs are beamed out to Mount Pisgah via
7,000 mcs microwave.
