This verifies your report of reception of Television Station WUNC-TV, Channel 4, Chapel Hill, North Carolina on November 28, 1966 from 0845 to 0945 EST.

The transmitter is located atop Terrell's Mountain, Chatham County. The power of the transmitter is 100 kw visual, and 20 kw aural.

Station WUNB-TV carries the same programs that WUNC-TV does.

The University FM station frequency is 91.5~mcs with a transmitter power of 10~kw and a radiated power of 50~kw.
