
Dear Mr. Andrews:

Thank you for your report of reception of Channel 3, KLNE-TV, Lexington, Nebraska, on June 5, 1968.

The equipment being used at KLNE-TV is primarily General Electric, with a six bay superturnstile antenna and TT-51-B 35 kw transmitter. The antenna overall height of 1065.6 feet above ground level. The effective radiated power is 100 kw.
