Your QSL for reception of WTTN November 2, 78 is this note.


I've been reluctant to acknowledge the reception because the operator on duty had failed to turn off the AM at local "sundown" as required for daytime stations. The operator has been duly reinstructed and advised that his failure could lead to serious trouble with the FCC.

Your later note to the station manager and proding from my assistant prompted me to send you this note. To date you are the only person who requested a QSL for the November 2nd after hours transmission.

WttN operates with 1KW daytime actually 940 watts from a half wave tower with WttN'Fm's antenna side mounted at the top. The extra tower height makes the antenna slightly more efficient than the normal quarter wave type and required the cutback of power to reduce radiation to the 1KW equivalent which keeps the Canadian government happy. 1580 is a Canadian clear channel frequency.

My function with the station is actually as a contract engineer. Our firm (see enclosed card) maintains several radio stations in Wisconsin.

Thank you again for your reception report. I trust you understand my reason for not acknowledging sooner.
