

Dear Mr. Cooper,

Your reception of WAMI, Opp, Alabama, on the morning of Nov. 11, 1953 is hereby verified. WAMI operates on 860 kc, 1000 watts.

Opp takes its name from Mr. Henry Opp, an early resident of this area. WAMI started program test on a regular schedule Dec. 13, 1952. We operate daytime only, at the present time from 6:15 am to 4:45 pm. I am enclosing a coverage map. This is only an estimate as no field strength measurements have been made. We have received mail from daytime listeners as far North as Sylacauga, and SE from Perry, Florida if you would care to look these up in a Rand-McNally. For some reason we have better than ordinary coverage. Freq. checks are made by Claude M. Grey, Birmingham. Meaning of Call sign: "W-here A-griculture M-eets I-ndustry". We are in a farming area, but have several factories around in the county and in Opp. Population, approximately 6,000.
