Thank you very much for your letter of May 16th and we are indeed happy to verify your reception report of WRWJ.

I hope you will excuse the delay in answering. As you may well guess, things have been moving fast lately and time has been at a premium. WRWJ went on the air on May 19th with 1000 watts power. We are daytime only and do not use a directional array. We are not affiliated with any network or any other station at this time. Selma has a population of between 35 and 40 thousand people as closely as I can tell and I'm afraid that I don't know how it got the name except that it is an Indian name. Sorry we don't have any coverage maps to send at this time and that we won't have to make early morning frequency checks since our monitoring service can read us in the daytime. Hope this answers all your questions.
