Dear Mr. Cooper

Please accept this letter as a reception verification from Radio Station W S P C in Anniston, Alabama.

Your report checked with our station log for October 2, 1949 at 2:15 am.

W S P C operates with 1,000 watts power on a frequency of 1390 KC, 24 hours daily. Our station closes operation from Sunday midnight until Monday 6:00 a.m. for equipment maintenance.

Our three tower directional system is set zero degrees true with the major power in the south direction.

An application is now before the F.C.C. to change operation to 10,000 watts, on 1550 K C.
