The report of your reception of this station is correct. We wish to thank you for your interest. We are on the air regularly from 2:00-2:15 AM CST the second Monday of each month, and from time to time we have equipment checks which generally last all night. We would appreciate having you in our listening audience. You must excuse my late confirmation but due to the vast amount of work even in a small station like this and also the vast amount of mail which we received from this one frequency check we decided to wait till all the mail was in and confirm all at the same time.

Our transmitter is a Gates 250-C-1. It has p.p. 810's in the final and p.p. 810's for the modulator. Our tower is 304' overall. This is three-eighths wavelength at our frequency. Apparently we either have better radiation to the east or the path is not open to the west, as the east is the direction from which we receive most mail.
