Dear Mr. Cooper:

In regard to letter of September 27, this is a verification of your reception report.

We went on the air at apporximately 12:30 am, as we do every first Tuesday of the month for our regular frequency check. However, this particular check was conducted on the fourth Tuesday because our frequency monitor was being repaired.

We modulate the transmitter with a 1,000 cycle tone with a station identification approximately every three minutes.

KWRF began operation in the latter part of 1953, and was owned at that time by three men: Willis, Rye, and Frazer, the initials of whom were used in the call letters. The station is presently owned by Mr. Weldon Sledge.

Thank you for your letter, and would appreciate hearing from you again if you receive us in Brooklyn.
