Dear Ernest,

This is to verify your reception of our Nov. 14, 1949 frequency check, 2:00-2:15AM M-S-T. We operate at a carrier power output of 250 watts on 1450 KC's. Antenna tower height of 192 feet. Douglas is located on the Mexican border at an altitude of 4000 feet above sea level. Our operating hours are from 6:30 AM to 11:00PM M-S-T. We cover a radius from 25 to 38 miles which is about 90% of Cochise county (the only county in the state named after one individual Indian). During the past 2 months our freq. checks have been heard in N.J., N.C., New York, New Jersey and Mass. We have had our signals picked up as far away as New Zealand (however this was before my time). Our regular frequency check schedule is the second Monday of each month from 2:00-2:15 AM M-S-T. T&T Radio Measurements of Compton, California does the monitor checks for our station. Weather at time of our Nov. 14th check was clear with temperature around 50 degrees.
