
Dear Mr. Cooper:

Thank you very much for your report of KCBS reception on January 26, 1952 from 11:51 p.m. to 12:07:15 a.m. PST on January 27, 1952. This has been checked with the station log and is hereby verified.

Now, to answer some of your questions...you are right, KCBS is using a very highly directional antenna, which is beamed northwest and southeast; and we operate from 5:30 a.m. to 12:15 a.m. PST daily. It is hard to say how wide an area KCBS covers by day and by night, although since we operate on 50 KWs, we blanket a very good portion of California and have had reports from a variety of states. KQW is now deleted, and several years ago when the Columbia Broadcasting System purchased the station, the call was changed to KCBS.
