Your report regarding the reception of our station has been received, and we are very grateful to you for the data it contained. You may consider this a confirmation of your report.

For your information, our studio building, in addition to staff offices, audition and rehearsal rooms, houses six separate broadcast studios, the largest of which is our Green Room Auditorium seating some 300 people,

The plant is equipped by the Radio Corporation of America, the control units being especially designed to meet our particular requirements.

Our transmitter is located in Culver City, eight miles from the studio, and is equipped with a new High Fidelity RCA five kilowatt transmitter as well as a one kilowatt stand-by transmitter. The antenna consists of a vertical radiator 485 feet high with a counterpoise system covering eleven acres of ground.

We, the staff of KEHE, extend best wishes for success in your future D.X. and trust our call letters may become a familiar entry in your log.
