Thanks for the letter on our reception in Brooklyn. I am very glad to hear that our signals do occasionally get that far east.

Our Transmitter is an R.C.A. 1000mwatt job high level modulated. It uses 833's final with 833's class B modulators. The antenna is a steel vertical tower 252 feet high with a top loading ring. The transmitter is located 2 miles East of town with studios in uptown Chico. We are a Mutual affiliate. Thanks again for the rpt.
