
This will verify your reception report of radio station WFIF from 1421 to 1721 EST on February 5, 1966.

If you use Citizens Band Radio we monitor channel 9 irregularly, however, a call to any unit in the area can be relayed to the station and we will gladly give you directions. It is less than five minutes from the Connecticut Thruway, a little further from the Merritt Parkway.

Although our tests are irregular I have set aside Monday morning, March 21, 1966 to run some tests for your members. I can not promise band music, however, we will do something.
