I have sent you a card of VERIFICATION for your reception report of our station on January 16, 1950 between 03:57:30 and 04:54 AM EST.

Our regular schedule:

Week days: Sign On at 06:28:30 AM to 11:00 PM EST
Saturdays: " " " " " " 12:00 PM EST
Sundays : " " " 07:59:15 " " 11:00 PM EST

Our Polio Campaign started this Sunday, January 15, 1950, at 07:59:15 AM EST and we have been on the air continuously so far and will remain so till we raise \$5000 or till the campaign ends on January 31, 1950. If the \$5000 is raised before Jan. 31, 1950 we shall terminate our twenty four hours a day of broadcasting on the day the sum is realized.

We do not conduct any frequency checks during the test periods. To date we use a dummy antenna during such test periods. RCA Lab. at Riverhead, L.I. sends us in a report once a month and keeps a constant check of any large deviation in our frequency.
