Here at W.P.C.T. we were pleasantly surprised to hear that we could be heard in Brooklyn. You see we are carrying all the day games of your favorites—the Brooklyn Dodgers. We're all hoping that they can come through with another pennant.

Perhaps you'd like to know a few facts about our station. We have studios in two cities. Our main studio is here in the Hotel Putnam, and our other studio is in Danielson which is about ten miles south of Putnam. We have been broadcasting since May of 1953 and went to 1kw in May of 1955. We are, of course, only a daytimer operating at the present from 6a.m. until 7:45pm. We are operating on remote control. From our Putnam studio, the transmitter is turned on and off, the output power is either raised or lowered, and all the meter readings of our final stage are taken. We employ Gates' equipment throughout except for a Berlant tape recorder.
