This is to verify your report of reception of WDOV on July 17, 1948, at 3:20 AM to 3:25 AM. Your notations check with our log.

WDOV is equipped with a Gates BC-1E 1 kw transmitter feeding, through an open-wire "caged" line, a 200' "Stainless" steel tower, located at 39 degs. 12 mins. 00 sec. north, 75 degs. 33 mins. 54 sec. west, or approximately 3 miles north of Dover, Delaware, along route 13.

We are at present operating from 6:00 AM to 8:30 PM. Our hour of operation are prescribed as follows:
