Thank you very much indeed for your report concerning the broadcast of our programs which you were able to tune in, in the U.S.A.

Details given by you confirm that they refer to our Radio-Lyon Station and we are giving you hereafter characteristics of our transmitter.

- Carrying wave power : 40 Kw.
- Frequency : 1.393 Kc
- Modulation : 90%
- Antenna : pylone radiating 1/2 wave, type Blaw-Knox 106 meters high.

Enclosed, please find photographs of same.

We are now studying the possibility of increasing the depth of our morning transmission 7 to 8.45 (French Summer time) which is one hour in advance on the Greenwich time. We should be very pleased to receive your report about same.
