Dear Sir,

The American Forces Network is interested in your January 21st letter, in which you indicate having received the signal from this radio station located in Stuttgart, Germany.

Because of the fact that several of these network stations conduct essentially the same type of program between 0600 and 0655 Mondays thru Saturdays, it would not be precisely possible to determine if ours was the station you heard on January 14th, 1951. The type of program you heard was probably an AFN station. Our transmitter is located on 1106 kcs.

At one time, this station operated upon 1249 kcs.

The transmitter site is located adjacent to Muehlacker, approximately 35 kilometers north-west of Stuttgart. We operate with a power of 100,000 watts. On several occasions in the past, we have had correspondence from persons on the east coast of the United States who indicated having heard our signal.

Thank you for your letter, and if in the future you hear our signal, we will be most pleased to hear from you.
