Dear Sir,

We thank you very much for your kind letter from December 6, 1953 in which we had a great interest. You told us your observations of the program on 1295 kcs. So we are sure it was our station Osterloog you have heard. We are transmitting our English program in the European Service daily from 08.00 - 08.30; 17.30 - 17.45; 19.15 - 19.30; 22.30 - 23.00 Central European Time.

Our station has a power of 110 kW. Our antenna is not directional and it consists of a self-radiating tubular mast, which is 132 m long and has a diameter of 0,9 m. The station has been built in 1939 by Telefunken, Berlin, and has been on the air for the British Broadcasting Corporation from 1947 till March 1950, and now from February 1953 until further notice.

If you are interested, we would appreciate it on this occasion if you would control our short wave transmitters of Osterloog. We broadcast to North America from 02.30 - 05.30 Central European Time on 5980 and 7290 kcs. If you have caught our short wave transmitters we would like to know in which volume and in which quality you have heard.

And now, though some late, a Happy and Prosperous New Year to you.
