Thank you for your informative report of November 25, 1965, relating to reception of the VOA Medium Wave transmitter of the Munich Relay Station operating on 1196 Kc during the period 0815 to 0830 CET.

This will acknowledge and confirm the accuracy of your observation. The transmitter is located near Ismaning, Germany (a suburb of Munich), it was operating with 300 KW power output, using a four-tower antenna array, being energized at that time in a non-directional configuration.

This is the only VOA Medium Wave Transmitter operating in Germany.

Your letter has been forwarded to our Washington Headquarters with my request that a VOA QSL card be provided for your files.
