Dear Ernest,

It was a thrill to hear from you again, in response to our "DX TEST" from WAMR.

I am pleased to VERIFY your reception in Provincetown, Mass of WAMR 1320 Venice, Fl on January 30, 1995 from 1:49-1:51 AM EST.

The fact that you heard the slowly rising tone is enough to prove that it was WAMR. I used the "sweep" tone as an attention getter, held it at 800hz then used the morse code ID. The sweep tone was a last second idea I had, and I'm glad I did it. Several reports could not have been verified without it.

WAMR was using our Daytime facilities of 5kw into a three tower Directional array. With a Common Point of 10 amps into a 54 ohm load, the Antenna Input Power was 5400 watts. At 2:00 AM I dropped power down to 1kw, but I don't think anyone heard that part of the test. Transmitter is a Harris MW-5 using two tubes. Backup is a Harris MW-1 Solid State.

Programming at WAMR is basically all talk, with a little CW in the morning. G.G.Liddy, RUSH, Brenner, and NBC TalkNet round things out. In fact, NBC originates TalkNet from WAMR on weekends for the David Essell show.

Thanks Ernest, for responding to our DX test. We plan to repeat it next year. So far, your report is the furthest I received. We thought Pat Martin might have caught something, but his "tentative" didn't pan out.
