I must apologize to you on behalf of our Chief Engineer Tom Middleton for his not responding to your original letter of January 27, 1971 regarding W A V S reception.

The facts stated in your letter regarding your reception are correct and we can thus verify your reception of our signal in Brooklyn, New York.

As you indicated, we are on the same frequency (1190kc) as is W O W O in Fort Wayne, and since they operate with 50,000 watts as compared to W A V S' 5,000 watts, it is unusual for such reception in your area.

We are grateful to you for the information and hope that you will drop us a line should you pick us up again.

So here is your #173 from Florida and keep up the good work.
