
Dear Mr. Cooper:

Your letter was received several days ago and we appreciated deeply your informative report on reception there. You are correct in assuming in your belief that you heard our test programming on the morning of May 9. Our frequency is 550, our power 1 kw and our rig is all Collins. Orange Park is located south of Jacksonville by about 12 miles on the St. Johns River. We are not certain about any scheduled program tests soon, but plan to begin regular programming Saturday morning May 28 at either 4 or 5 a.m. I am not certain as yet. Would appreciate your letting us know if you manage to pick up our signal. We will follow this schedule on a 7-day basis. We sign off at local sunset. We hope within a year to go to 5 kw.

Thanks again for your report and for all the other wonderful hams who wrote. Our Chief Engineer was unable to answer this at the moment because of so many jobs in getting ready to go on the air, but may I convey his personal thanks to you.
