Dear Mr. Cooper:

Thank you for your letter of February 17, 1949, reporting reception of our special FCC test on the morning of February 16, between 2:41:30 and 2:46:45 AM. Your report has been checked with our log and we are pleased to verify your reception of WGBS.

We have been conducting some special tests ordered by the FCC for the purpose of gathering data to be used in a NARBA conference soon to be held.

On December 21, 1948, we started using the new WGBS 50,000-watt transmitter which is located about five miles northwest of Hialeah, Florida, where we radiate 50,000 watts daytime and 10,000 watts at night. We are on the air from 6:00 AM until 1:00 AM weekdays, and on Sundays from 8:00 AM until 12:30 AM. Our assigned frequency is, as you know, 710 kc.

Your detailed report is very much appreciated.
