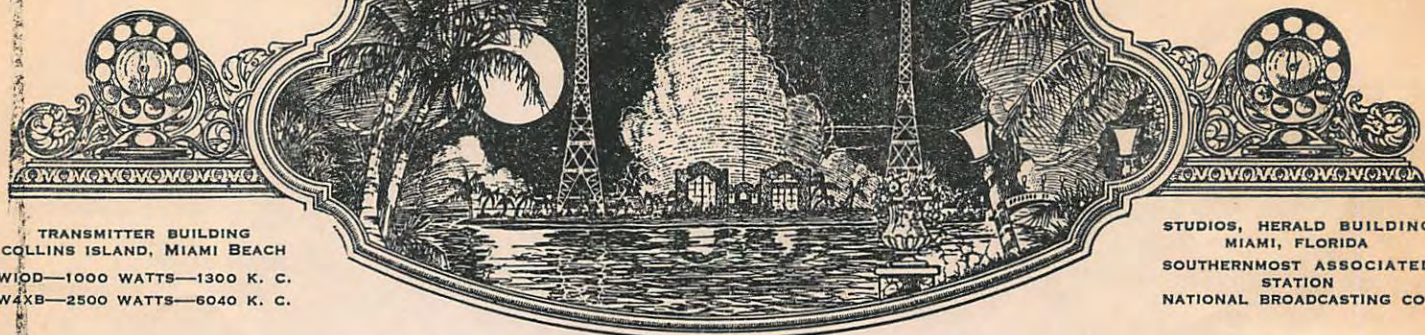

WIOD, the southernmost associated station of the National Broadcasting Company, is operated on a frequency of 1300 kilocycles or an equivalent wave length of 230.6 meters.
